ESL Support – Mandatory for A1 to B1 Level Students **\$4,500.00/Year \$1,500.00/Trimester (\$20/hour)** Assessment will occur in-school to determine needs within the first 2 weeks of attendance.

Referral Credit –SLA families can receive up to \$500.00 credit for each new family who enrolls in SLA when they are listed as the referring family on the official admissions form. *Referral credit will be split if new families list more than one family on their admissions form.*

Discounts – SLA offers families sibling discounts. Please contact the office for more information.

Credit card information must be provided for the year's remittance upon registration. *Payments by credit card are subject to a credit fee of 4%.*

Payments must be completed on or before due dates. All overdue balances will be assessed at a rate of **2% monthly**.

Uniforms – School uniforms are not included in the outlined fees and must be purchased separately through Land's End Uniform company at www.landsend.com

Medical Requirements and Hospital Insurance – Under Ontario Law, all students are required to have appropriate immunization prior to entering the Academy. The Medical Officer of Health is required to enforce this regulation. **By law all students must satisfy this requirement.** All students must have health insurance coverage provided by Ontario Hospital Insurance Plan, another provincial health plan or the equivalent thereof. Students who do not have coverage must purchase medical insurance or provide satisfactory evidence of alternative insurance.

To attend school in Ontario, international students must show proof of immunization against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, and varicella (for those born in 2010 or later).

Exemptions:

Students can be exempt from vaccination for medical, religious, or conscientious reasons.

You must complete and submit the appropriate form, available on the Government of Ontario website www.forms.mgcs.gov.on.ca.

Additional Information:

Immunization Records: Students must provide proof of immunization to the school.

Medical Insurance: Students may require medical insurance during their stay.

- **Meningococcal B (Meningitis B):** Two-dose series (not publicly funded). International Students are strongly recommended to get vaccinated for Meningitis B through Student Health Services as soon as they arrive on campus.
- **Hepatitis B:** Recommended for health care workers who may be exposed to blood or body fluids.

- **Influenza:** The influenza (flu) vaccination is not mandatory but strongly recommended.
- **Tuberculosis** (TB) screening: UTTC (United Tribes Technical College) has adopted the NDUS 506.1 requirement for all international students from all countries to be tested for TB unless from a country identified as low risk.
- **HPV vaccine:** In Ontario, the HPV vaccine is offered for free to all children in Grade 7. HPV vaccination is not mandatory but it is recommended.

Personal Property Insurance – The St. Lawrence Academy cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to a student’s personal property. Parents should ensure that students’ personal belongings and anything else of value are insured while at school. Labeling clothing, particularly uniform items is also very important.
