2026-27 School Fee Information

A. Tuition Fees for 2026-2027

Activity Fee (Kindergarten - Grade 8)	\$250.00
Junior & Senior Kindergarten	\$9,750.00
Grades 1 - 8	\$11,750.00

B. Enrollment/Re-enrollment Fee \$500.00

The following fees will be due upon acceptance of enrollment or re-enrollment of each student.

Activity Fee of \$250.00, which covers the cost of field trips, athletic events, classroom and student supplies.

Enrollment Deposit of \$250.00, which holds the student's spot and is applied to the total tuition owed for the school year.

Both fees are per student and are non-refundable.

C. Tuition Payment Options:

The following options are available for payment of the remaining balance of the student's tuition.

Option 1 – Single Payment Plan Due August 1st (or upon enrollment)

Junior & Senior Kindergarten	\$9,500.00
Grades 1 to Grade 8	\$11,500.00

Option 2 – Monthly Installment Plan (Installments secured by e-Transfers or post-dated cheques)**

Those who wish to pay by equal installments may do so over 10 months beginning on **August 1st (or upon enrolment)**. Payment is due on the 1st of each month.

****This plan includes a 5% administration charge.**

Financial Assistance and Discounts – A 10% sibling discount is available to families with more than one child attending St. Lawrence Academy.

A limited amount of further financial assistance is available and may be awarded based on demonstrated need, up to 50% of tuition. Any sibling discounts will be applied to the total amount owed after Apple Financial assistance is calculated. If you wish to apply for financial assistance, an application form can be requested online at www.applefinancialservices.ca. **Applications must be submitted to Apple Financial annually.**

D. Additional Fees:

The following additional and optional costs are not included in the outlined tuition fees above.

- **Bussing** – For the 2026/27 school year bussing costs are projected to be a minimum of \$2500.00/year/child dependent on ridership numbers. We will require a minimum of 20 students riding the bus in order to offer transportation.
- **Homework Club/After-school care** – This is an additional fee which will be determined and advertised as of August 1st of each year. Information will be sent directly to parents to consider.
- **Hot Lunch Program** - This is an optional fee and is based on the meal plan selected. Information regarding the hot lunch program is available upon request.
- **Uniforms** – School uniforms are not included in the outlined fees and must be purchased separately through Land's End Uniform company at www.landsend.com
- **Private Music Lessons** - The school offers private lessons at the school on select days throughout the year. Information is available upon request.
- **Tutor Surcharge** – should the student require a learning tutor, the cost will be determined between the tutor and the family.

E. Notes:

- **Referral Credit** –SLA families can receive up to \$500.00 credit for each new family who enrolls in SLA when they are listed as the referring family on the official admissions form. *Referral credit will be split if new families list more than one family on their admissions form.*
- **All remittances must be made in Canadian funds payable** to The St Lawrence Academy.
- **Payments must be completed on or before the due dates** - **All overdue balances will be assessed at a rate of 2% monthly.**
- **Cancellation Fee** – When a student is enrolled at the beginning of the year, it is intended that the space be reserved for the full year. Administration Fees and enrollment deposits are charged on an annual basis, and no portion of said fees paid will be refunded or outstanding fees cancelled in the event of the student's absence, withdrawal, or dismissal from The St. Lawrence Academy after September 1st of the enrolling school year.
- **Medical Requirements and Hospital Insurance** – Under Ontario Law, all students are required to have appropriate immunization before entering school. The Medical Officer of Health is required to enforce this regulation. **By law, all students must satisfy this requirement.** All students must have health insurance coverage provided by the Ontario Hospital Insurance Plan, another provincial health plan or the equivalent thereof. Students who do not have coverage must purchase medical insurance or provide satisfactory evidence of alternative insurance.
- **Personal Property Insurance** – The St. Lawrence Academy cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to a student's personal property. Parents should ensure that students' personal belongings and anything else of value are insured while at school. Labelling clothing, particularly uniform items, is also very important.

Receipts for Canadian income tax purposes - will be issued in February for a portion of the tuition fee.
